### **SIGN INSTALLATION REQUIRES OVERNIGHT LANE CLOSURE ON INTERSTATE 630 IN LITTLE ROCK**

**LITTLE ROCK (11-18)** – Sign installation will require an overnight lane closure on Interstate 630 in Little Rock, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Crews will be installing an overhead sign on the Barrow Road overpass. The work will reduce I-630 westbound traffic to one lane. The lane closures will extend from one mile east of Barrow Road, to just west of Barrow Road.

The lane closures will be Thursday night through Friday morning, between 9:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m., weather permitting. Traffic will be controlled using barrels and warning signs.

Motorists should exercise caution when approaching and traveling through all highway work zones.
