## **IMPROVEMENTS TO U.S. HIGHWAY 67 WILL REQUIRE A DETOUR IN WHITE COUNTY**

**LITTLE ROCK (11-21)** – Improvements to U.S. Highway 67 will require a detour in White County, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Crews will be repairing the southbound shoulder within a 5-mile construction area between Highways 157 and 167. The work will require detouring traffic at Exit 51 (Hwy. 157 Exit) near Judsonia. Drivers will be detoured east to Highway 367 and then south to Highway 385. Drivers can then turn west on Highway 385 to access Highway 67 at mile marker 48.

The detour will be Tuesday, November 25<sup>th</sup>, between 7:00 a.m. and 12:00 noon, weather permitting. Traffic will be controlled using barrels and detour signs.

Motorists should exercise caution when approaching and traveling through all highway work zones.
