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PAVEMENT TESTING REQUIRES LANE CLOSURES ON U.S. HIGHWAY 67 IN PULASKI AND LONOKE COUNTIES

LITTLE ROCK (12-1) - Pavement research will require daytime lane closures on U.S. Highway 67 in Pulaski and Lonoke counties, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Crews will perform pavement testing on the southbound inside shoulder of Highway 67, extending from Highway 5 in Cabot to West Main Street in Jacksonville (mm 16-11). The work will reduce southbound traffic to one lane.

The lane closure will be Tuesday, December 2nd between 10:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m., weather permitting. Traffic will be controlled using traffic cones and warning signs.

This project is necessary preparation for the future widening of U.S. Highway 67 between Jacksonville and Cabot. It's part of AHTD's Connecting Arkansas Program. More information on this project is available at ConnectingArkansasProgram.com.
