### **PAVEMENT RESEARCH REQUIRES WEEKEND LANE CLOSURES ON INTERSTATE 630 IN LITTLE ROCK**

**LITTLE ROCK (12-4)** – Pavement research will require weekend lane closures on Interstate 630 in Little Rock, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Crews will be taking core samples from Interstate 630 between John Barrow Road and University Avenue. The work will require roving closures of the eastbound and westbound outside lanes of Interstate 630 within the work zone.

The lane closure will be **Saturday, December 6<sup>th</sup> and Sunday, December 7<sup>th</sup>, between 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.**, weather permitting. Traffic will be controlled using barrels and warning signs.

This project is necessary preparation for the proposed future widening of Interstate 630 between Baptist Health Medical Center and University Avenue. It is part of AHTD's Connecting Arkansas Program.
