BRIDGE INSPECTIONS REQUIRE LANE CLOSURES ON INTERSTATE 440 IN NORTH LITTLE ROCK

LITTLE ROCK (12-5) – Routine bridge inspections will require lane closures on Interstate 440 in North Little Rock, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Crews will be inspecting eastbound and westbound bridges over Faulkner Lake, located just north of Faulkner Lake Road. The work will require closing the eastbound and westbound outside lanes between mile markers 8 and 9.

The eastbound outside lane closure will be Monday, December 8th and Tuesday, December 9th, between 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m., weather permitting. The westbound outside lane will be Wednesday, December 10th and Thursday, December 11th, between 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m., weather permitting. Traffic will be controlled using barrels and warning signs.

These bridges were constructed in 1979. They are 2,240 feet in length and 59 feet in width.
