RAILROAD WORK REQUIRES PARTIAL CLOSURE OF HIGHWAY 367 (ARCH STREET) IN LITTLE ROCK

LITTLE ROCK (12-18) – Railroad work will require the partial closure on Highway 367 (Arch Street) in Little Rock, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Crews will perform repairs on the railroad near the 3M Plant as well as a conveyor belt located over Highway 367 (Photo Attached). The work will require closing Highway 367 (Arch Street) to all traffic between Baseline Road and Interstate 30. A detour route will be provided.

The road will be closed 24 hours per day beginning Saturday, December 20th at 8:00 a.m. and ending Monday, December 22nd at 5:00 p.m., weather permitting.
