REMOUNT ROAD REOPENS TO TRAFFIC DETOUR REMOVED IN NORTH LITTLE ROCK

LITTLE ROCK (12-23) – Remount Road in North Little Rock has reopened to traffic, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

The Arkansas Highway Commission awarded a contract to Mobley Contractors, Inc. of Morrilton to remove the existing bridge on Remount Road in North Little Rock at a cost of \$570,871.86.

The work was performed over Five Mile Creek, just south of North Little Rock Airport. The work required closing Remount Road just north of Camp Robinson Road and just south of Mission Road, which is located just south of North Little Rock Airport.

The existing bridge was constructed in 1939. It was 25 feet wide and 30 feet in length. This structure was replaced with a triple-opening, reinforced concrete box culvert.

Although the roadway is open to traffic, additional work is still required that may require future brief lane closures.
