RAILROAD WORK REQUIRES CLOSURE OF HIGHWAY 109 IN JOHNSON COUNTY

LITTLE ROCK (12-31) – Railroad work will require the temporary closure of Highway 109 in southern Johnson County, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

A Union Pacific Railroad crew will be making repairs at the Highway 109 crossing between Clarksville and Morrison Bluff. The work will require closing Highway 109 at the crossing on Sunday, January 4th, between 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., weather permitting. Signs will direct traffic to a detour route using Highways 64 and 23.
