ARKANSAS HIGHWAY COMMISSION APPROVES BID FOR IMPROVEMENTS IN PRAIRIE COUNTY

LITTLE ROCK (4-27) - The Arkansas State Highway Commission approved a bid for improvements to roadways in Prairie County, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

The purpose of the project is to resurface 2 miles of roadway in Ulm.

Redstone Construction Group, Inc. of Little Rock, Arkansas was awarded the contract at \$160,312.23.

This project is being funded through the State Aid City Streets Program approved by lawmakers in 2011 and voters in 2012. This program provides \$20 million annually from the state motor fuels tax to assist cities with projects selected by a 9-member panel of Arkansas mayors.

Construction is scheduled to begin in two to four weeks, weather permitting. The project should be complete this spring.
