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ARKANSAS HIGHWAY COMMISSION APPROVES BID FOR IMPROVEMENTS IN CLARK COUNTY

LITTLE ROCK (6-15) - The Arkansas State Highway Commission has approved a bid for improvements to roadways in Clark County, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

The purpose of the project is to resurface 3.2 miles of County Roads 11, 19, and 76. Additional information is listed below.

Cranford Construction Company of North Little Rock, Arkansas was awarded the contract at \$407,246.13.

This county road project is funded through the State Aid Road Program established by the legislature and administered by the State Aid Division of the Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department. This program provides approximately \$20 million annually from the state motor fuels tax to assist counties with projects of their choosing on the county road system.
