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ARKANSAS HIGHWAY COMMISSION APPROVES BID FOR IMPROVEMENTS IN INDEPENDENCE COUNTY

LITTLE ROCK (4-27) - The Arkansas State Highway Commission approved a bid for improvements to roadways in Independence County, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

The purpose of the project is to resurface 3.4 mile of County Road 10 (Jamestown Loop) and County Road 88. The locations are listed below.

Road	Work Zone	Miles
County Rd. 10 (Jamestown Loop)	Extends W. from Camp Tahkodah Rd.	1
County Rd. 88 (N. Charlotte Rd.)	Extends N. from Hwy. 25	2.4

Atlas Asphalt, Inc. of Batesville, Arkansas was awarded the contract at \$258,167.27.

This county road project is funded through the State Aid Road Program established by the legislature and administered by the State Aid Division of the Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department. This program provides approximately \$20 million annually from the state motor fuels tax to assist counties with projects of their choosing on the county road system.

Construction is scheduled to begin in two to four weeks, weather permitting. The project should be complete by this summer.
