ARKANSAS HIGHWAY COMMISSION APPROVES BID FOR IMPROVEMENTS IN UNION COUNTY

LITTLE ROCK (6-15) - The Arkansas State Highway Commission has approved a bid for improvements to roadways in Union County, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

The purpose of the project is to resurface 2.2 miles of roadway in Felsenthal and 1.1 mile of roadway in Strong. Additional information is listed below.

Jet Asphalt & Rock Company, Inc. of El Dorado, Arkansas was awarded the contract at \$498,112.85.

This project is part of the State Aid City Streets Program approved by lawmakers in 2011 and voters in 2012. This program provides \$20 million annually from the state motor fuels tax to assist cities with projects selected by a nine member panel of Arkansas mayors.
