CONSTRUCTION WORK REQUIRES LANE CLOSURES AT I-430/630 INTERCHANGE IN LITTLE ROCK

LITTLE ROCK (1-26) – Construction work will require lane closures at the Interstate 430/630 (Big Rock) Interchange in Little Rock, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Crews will construct curb and gutter. The work will require closing the following lanes:

- The inside lane of I-630 westbound from the I-430 bridge to Shackleford Rd.
- The inside lanes of both northbound and southbound traffic on Shackleford Rd. from Birchwood to Financial Centre Parkway.

The lane closures will be **Monday, January 26th through Friday, January 30th** between 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m., weather permitting. Traffic will be controlled using barrels and warning signs.

Crews will also install drain pipe on the I-630 westbound to I-430 southbound flyover ramp. The work will require closing the following lanes:

• The inside lane of I-630 eastbound from Shackleford Road to the Baptist Health ramp.

This lane closure will be **Wednesday**, **January 28**th **through Friday**, **January 30**th, between 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m., weather permitting.

This project is part of a \$125 million plan to reconstruct the I-430/I-630 (Big Rock) Interchange. The entire project is scheduled to be complete this summer.
