## BRIDGE INSPECTION REQUIRES LANE CLOSURE ON HIGHWAY 367 (ARCH STREET) IN LITTLE ROCK

**LITTLE ROCK (4-3)** – A routine bridge inspection will require lane closures on Highway 367 (Arch Street) in Little Rock, according to the Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Crews will inspect the bridge located over the Union Pacific railroad, just north of Interstate 30. The work will require closing the northbound lane on the bridge. This will reduce traffic to one lane controlled by flaggers.

The northbound lane closure will be **Monday, April 6<sup>th</sup> and Tuesday, April 7<sup>th</sup>,** between 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m., each day, weather permitting. Traffic will be controlled using flaggers, cones and warning signs.

Drivers should exercise caution when approaching and traveling through all highway work zones.
