IMPROVEMENTS TO INTERSTATE 430 REQUIRE LANE CLOSURES IN LITTLE ROCK

LITTLE ROCK (6-26) – Improvements to Interstate 430 require lane closures in Little Rock, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Crews will stripe and patch pavement on Interstate 430 between the pedestrian overpass (N. of W. Markham St.) and the Shackleford Road exit. The work will reduce traffic to one or two lanes within the work zone.

Traffic will be reduced to one lane **Sunday night, June 28th through Thursday morning, July 2nd** between 9:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m., each night, weather permitting.

Traffic will be reduced to two lanes **Monday, June 29th through Wednesday, July 1st** between 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m., each day, weather permitting.
