REPAIR WORK REQUIRES INTERSTATE 40 CLOSURE & DETOUR IN MONROE COUNTY

LITTLE ROCK (1-12) – Repair work will require closing Interstate 40 westbound in Monroe County, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Crews will repair a damaged guardrail located within a construction zone at mile marker 208. The work will require closing Interstate 40 westbound at mile marker 216 in Brinkley. Traffic will be detoured using Highway 49 South to Highway 70 and then Highway 33 North, back to Interstate 40, just east of the White River (mile marker 202). Detour signs will clearly mark the route.

The Interstate 40 westbound closure will be Wednesday night, January 14th through Thursday morning, January 15th between 11:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m., weather permitting. Traffic will be controlled using barrels and warning signs.
