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CONSTRUCTION WORK REQUIRES LANE CLOSURES AT I-430/630 INTERCHANGE IN LITTLE ROCK

LITTLE ROCK (1-22) – Construction work will require lane closures at the Interstate 430/630 (Big Rock) Interchange in Little Rock, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Crews will remove the construction safety platforms from the I-430 northbound to I-630 eastbound bridge and the I-630 westbound to I-430 southbound bridge. Crews will also stripe the highway and construct a wall on the I-430 northbound to I-630 eastbound bridge. The work will require closing the following lanes:

- The inside turn lane from southbound Shackleford Rd. to I-630 eastbound.
- The inside lane of Financial Centre Parkway from Hardin/Hermitage.
- The two inside eastbound lanes of I-630 from Shackleford Road to the Baptist Health exit ramp.

The lane closures will be **Saturday, January 24th**, between 6:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m., weather permitting. Traffic will be controlled using barrels and warning signs.

This project is part of a \$78 million plan to reconstruct the I-430/I-630 (Big Rock) Interchange. The entire project is scheduled to be complete this summer.
