## **BRIDGE MAINTENANCE REQUIRES LANE CLOSURES ON INTERSTATE 40 IN LONOKE COUNTY**

**LITTLE ROCK (1-23)** – Routine bridge maintenance will require a lane closure on Interstate 40 in Lonoke County, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Crews will repair delaminated concrete on the soffit of the Highway 13 overpass in Carlisle. The work will require closing the I-40 eastbound outside lane between mile markers 181 and 183. It will also be necessary to restrict the width of the eastbound exit to Highway 13 (Exit 183).

The eastbound outside lane closure will be **Monday, January 26<sup>th</sup> and Tuesday, January 27<sup>th</sup>**, between 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m., weather permitting. Traffic will be controlled using barrels and warning signs.

Drivers should exercise caution when approaching and traveling through all highway work zones.
