CONSTRUCTION ON U.S. HIGHWAY 67 REQUIRES TRAFFIC SHIFTS IN JACKSONVILLE

LITTLE ROCK (1-30) – Construction work will require traffic shifts on U.S. Highway 67 in Jacksonville, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Crews are constructing new Redmond Road and Main Street overpasses. The work will require northbound and southbound traffic to shift on Highway 67 north of Main Street and south of Redmond Road. Both northbound lanes will shift east on the shoulder and outside lane and southbound lanes will shift to the east on temporary pavement and the inside lane.

The northbound and southbound traffic shifts will begin Monday at 9:00 p.m., weather permitting. This will continue until the next phase of construction. Traffic will be controlled using barrels and warning signs.
