### **IMPROVEMENTS TO INTERSTATES 40 AND 430 REQUIRE OVERNIGHT LANE CLOSURES IN NORTH LITTLE ROCK**

**LITTLE ROCK (2-6)** – Improvements to Interstates 40 and 430 will require lane closures in Pulaski County, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Crews will install a precast barrier wall and perform construction at the I-40/I-430 interchange in North Little Rock. The work will require closing the I-40 eastbound and westbound inside lanes near the interchange. The work will also reduce the width of the I-40 west to I-430 south (to Little Rock) and the I-430 north to I-40 westbound ramps (to Conway). Traffic will be controlled using warning signs and barrels.

Alternating eastbound and westbound inside lane closures will occur between **Monday evening, February 9<sup>th</sup> and Saturday morning, February 14<sup>th</sup>**. The eastbound lane closures will be between 8:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. The westbound lane closures will be between 9:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m.

This project is part of AHTD's Connecting Arkansas Program and completes the widening of Interstate 40 between Conway and North Little Rock. The project widens I-40 to three lanes in each direction.
