BRIDGE INSPECTION REQUIRES LANE CLOSURES ON INTERSTATE 40 NEAR WEST MEMPHIS

LITTLE ROCK (3-20) – A routine bridge inspection will require a lane closure on Interstate 40 near West Memphis, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Crews will inspect the two main arch truss spans of the I-40 Mississippi River Bridge between Arkansas and Tennessee. The work will require closing the I-40 westbound outside lane on the bridge.

The Interstate 40 westbound outside lane closures will be **Monday, March 23rd through Thursday, April 2nd**, between 6:30 a.m. and 4:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, weather permitting. The closures on Saturday and Sunday will occur between 6:30 a.m. and 7:30 p.m., weather permitting. Traffic will be controlled using barrels, cones and warning signs.
