AHTD TO HOLD PUBLIC INVOLVEMENT MEETING IN EL DORADO

LITTLE ROCK (3-25) - The Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) will hold a Public Involvement Meeting in EL Dorado to discuss plans to rehabilitate Highway 335 in Union County.

The construction work will extend south from Highway 7 to Highway 82, west of El Dorado.

The meeting will be held **Tuesday, March 31st**, from 4:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m., at Wyatt Baptist Church (Fellowship Hall). It is located at 4621 Hillsboro Street in El Dorado.
