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BRIDGE INSPECTION REQUIRES LANE CLOSURES ON BROADWAY BRIDGE BETWEEN LITTLE ROCK & NORTH LITTLE ROCK

LITTLE ROCK (3-27) – A routine bridge inspection will require lane closures on the Broadway Bridge between Little Rock and North Little Rock, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

The work will require closing the northbound (eastbound) and southbound (westbound) outside lanes.

- **The northbound (eastbound) outside lane closure will be Monday, March 30th and Tuesday, March 31st between 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m., each day, weather permitting.**
- **The southbound (westbound) outside lane closure will be Tuesday, March 31st through Thursday, April 2nd, between 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m., each day, weather permitting.**

The bridge was constructed in 1923. The arch was added in 1974. Its length is 2,354 feet. Its width is 60 feet. An average of 25,000 vehicles use the bridge each day. The bridge will soon be replaced. The current bridge will close for approximately 6 months, beginning next spring. The \$98.4 million project is estimated to be complete in early 2017.
