### **WORK ON HIGHWAY 167 REQUIRES LANE CLOSURES IN CALHOUN COUNTY**

**LITTLE ROCK (4-3)** –Work on Highway 167 will require lane closures in Calhoun County, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Crews will perform pavement testing on Highway 167. The work will extend from County Road 128 in Hampton to Highway 274. The work will reduce traffic to one lane, alternately closing the northbound and southbound lanes and shoulders.

The lane closures will be **Monday, April 6<sup>th</sup> through Wednesday, April 8<sup>th</sup>**, weather permitting. Traffic will be controlled using cones and flaggers.
