### **IMPROVEMENTS TO HIGHWAY 167B REQUIRE LOAD RESTRICTIONS IN GRANT COUNTY**

**LITTLE ROCK (4-10)** – Improvements to Highway 167B will require load restrictions in Grant County, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Crews will be widening Highway 167B northbound. The work will extend north one tenth of a mile from the intersection of Highway 167B and Highway 167, south of Sheridan. During construction, the work zone will be restricted to loads less than 12 feet in width.

The load restriction will be **Monday, April 13<sup>th</sup> at 8:00 a.m. through Thursday, April 16<sup>th</sup> at 5:00 p.m.**, weather permitting. Traffic will be controlled using, barrels and warning signs.

Motorists should exercise caution when approaching and traveling through all highway work zones.
