CONSTRUCTION REQUIRES I-430 & I-630 LANE CLOSURES IN LITTLE ROCK

LITTLE ROCK (4-10) – Construction work will require lane closures on Interstates 430 and 630 in Little Rock, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Weather permitting, crews will grind uneven sections of I-430 northbound, remove temporary barrier wall on I-630 westbound, and paint steel beams on the I-630 westbound to Interstate 430 southbound flyover. The work will require the following closures **Monday, April 13th through Friday morning, April 17th. Note: Interstate 430 will only be reduced to one lane during the overnight hours.**

I-630 Westbound	inside	Baptist Health Ramp to Shackelford Rd.	Mon-Fri morning 9am-3pm 9pm-5am
