IMPROVEMENTS TO I-430 REQUIRE LANE CLOSURES IN LITTLE ROCK

LITTLE ROCK (4-17) – Improvements to Interstate 430 will require lane closures in Little Rock, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Crews will grind the pavement to level the driving surface. The work will be performed on I-430 northbound from ¼ mile south of the Markham Street overpass to the pedestrian overpass. The work will reduce I-430 traffic to only the inside lane. During this lane reduction, drivers traveling from I-630 westbound to I-430 northbound must yield to I-430 northbound traffic.

The I-430 northbound lane closures will be **Monday night, April 20th through Friday morning, April 24th, between 9:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m.**, each night, weather permitting. Traffic will be controlled using barrels and warning signs.
