## **IMPROVEMENTS TO I-630 REQUIRE LANE CLOSURES IN LITTLE ROCK**

**LITTLE ROCK (4-17)** – Improvements to Interstate 630 will require lane closures in Little Rock, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Crews will install overhead sign structures on Interstate 630 westbound between the Baptist Health exit and the Interstate 430 north access ramp. The work will reduce I-630 traffic to only the outside lane. Traffic may be stopped intermittently during the installation.

The I-630 westbound lane closures will be **Sunday, April 19<sup>th</sup> between 6:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m., weather permitting.** Traffic will be controlled using barrels and warning signs.

Crews will also remove a temporary barrier wall. The work will require closing the inside lane of Interstate 630 westbound from Baptist Health to Shackelford Road.

This I-630 westbound inside lane closure will be **Monday, April 20<sup>th</sup> through Friday, April 24<sup>th</sup>, between 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m.,** each day, weather permitting.

Drivers should exercise caution when approaching and traveling through all highway work zones.
