## **RAILROAD WORK REQUIRES HIGHWAY 264 DETOUR IN BETHEL HEIGHTS**

**LITTLE ROCK (4-22)** – Railroad work and drainage improvements will require closing a portion of Highway 264 in Bethel Heights, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.


Crews will construct a new drainage structure and railroad crossing near N. Oak Street. The work will require closing the railroad crossing. Traffic will be detoured using Old Wire Rd, Randle Wobbe Lane and Highway 71B (see attached map). Local non-truck traffic needing access between the railroad and the culvert crossing will be routed on North Oak Street & County Line Road during the operations.

The closure at the Highway 264 railroad crossing will be **Saturday, April 25<sup>th</sup> at 6:00 a.m. until Monday, April 27<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 a.m.**, weather permitting. Traffic will be controlled using barrels, warning and detour signs.

Drivers should exercise caution when approaching and traveling through all highway work zones.
