IMPROVEMENTS TO INTERSTATE 630 REQUIRE LANE CLOSURES IN LITTLE ROCK

LITTLE ROCK (5-1) – Improvements to Interstate 630 require lane closures in Little Rock, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Crews will stripe and open the I-630 westbound lanes on the new Shackleford Road overpass. The work will require closing the inside lane of Interstate 630. The closure will extend from the Barrow Road exit to Shackleford Road.

The westbound lane closures will be **Saturday, May 2nd and Sunday, May 3rd**, between 6:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m., each day, weather permitting. Traffic will be controlled using barrels and warning signs.
