SIGN REPLACEMENT REQUIRES I-430 LANE CLOSURES IN LITTLE ROCK

LITTLE ROCK (5-8) – Sign replacement will require Interstate 430 lane closures in Little Rock, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Crews will be replacing signs above Interstate 430 southbound between Rodney Parham Road and the exit ramp to Interstate 630. The work will reduce traffic to 1 or 2 lanes. The specific lane closed will vary as work progresses.

The closures will be **Sunday night, May 10th through Friday morning, May 15th**, between 9:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m., each night, weather permitting. Traffic will be controlled using barrels and warning signs.
