FLOOD DAMAGE CLOSURES A PORTION OF HIGHWAY 234 IN LITTLE RIVER COUNTY

LITTLE ROCK (5-11) – Flood damage has closed part of Highway 234 in Little River County, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Crews will replace a damaged drainage structure on Highway 234 near Winthrop, between Ashdown and DeQueen. Detour routes will be indicated using Highway 41 South and Highway 108 East (Map is attached).

It's estimated the road will be **closed until Wednesday at 5:00 p.m.**, weather permitting.

Traffic will be controlled using barrels as well as warning and detour signs.
