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ALL-WAY STOP SIGNS TO BE INSTALLED AT THE INTERSECTION OF STATE HIGHWAY 32/32Y IN ASHDOWN

LITTLE ROCK (5-21) – Stop signs will be installed at the intersection of State Highway 32 and 32Y in Ashdown, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

A recent on-site review of the intersection by AHTD traffic engineers determined it meets the warrants for an ALL-WAY stop condition. Also known as a “four-way stop,” the ALL-WAY stop requires all traffic in all directions to stop before proceeding through the intersection.

Weather permitting, work is to begin on Tuesday, May 26th and will include the installation of the ALL-WAY stop signs as well as advance warning signs indicating a change in the traffic pattern ahead. Pavement markings in the form of stop bars will also be installed. A stop bar is a flat pavement marking that indicates where traffic is to stop before proceeding into the intersection. Additional pavement markings include the text STOP AHEAD, which will be placed prior to the intersection. Portable electronic message boards will be temporarily installed to help promote the traffic pattern change.

Dry pavement is required for the installation of pavement markings. In the event of rain, the work will be rescheduled as soon as possible.
