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### **BARRIER WALL RELOCATION REQUIRES INTERSTATE 30 LANE CLOSURE IN LITTLE ROCK**

**LITTLE ROCK (5-25)** – The relocation of a barrier wall will require closing a lane on Interstate 30 in Little Rock, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Crews will relocate the barrier wall on Interstate 30 westbound near the old Exit 128 near Otter Creek Road and in front of Bass Pro Shops. The work will reduce traffic to 2 lanes within the work zone.

The westbound lane closure will be **Wednesday night, May 27<sup>th</sup> and Thursday morning, May 28<sup>th</sup>**, between 8:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m., each day, weather permitting. If weather prohibits the work, the closure will be delayed until the following night. Traffic will be controlled using barrels and warning signs.

Drivers should exercise caution when approaching and traveling through all highway work zones.
