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CONSTRUCTION WORK REQUIRES LANE CLOSURES AT I-430/630 “BIG ROCK” INTERCHANGE IN LITTLE ROCK

LITTLE ROCK (5-26) – Construction work will require lane closures at the Interstate 430/630 “Big Rock” interchange in Little Rock, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Crews will be applying final pavement markings on Shackelford Road. The work will require lane closures **Wednesday, May 27th through Friday, May 29th**, weather permitting. The specific lane closed will change as work progresses.

Additionally, crews will be preparing the pavement markings for the new flyover that carries traffic from I-430 southbound to I-630 eastbound. The work will require a closure of the outside I-430 southbound lane between Rodney Parham and I-630 **Wednesday, May 27th through Friday, May 29th**.

Traffic will be controlled using barrels and warning signs at the following times and locations.
