High Water Prompts Immediate Closure on State Highway 108 in Little River County

LITTLE ROCK (5-30) – High water where State Highway 108 crosses Walnut Bayou in Little River County has prompted the closure of a section of the route, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

The closure includes 3.5 miles of State Highway 108 between the Oklahoma State Line (west end) and the intersection with Little River County Road 20 (east end).

Water has reached the bottom of the beams of the bridge over Walnut Bayou and the structure is at risk of being overtopped.

This closing is being coordinated with the Oklahoma Department of Transportation. Barricades and signs are being placed to warn motorists of the closure at the Oklahoma State Line as well as at the intersection with Little River County Road 20.
