TESTING ON HIGHWAY 167 REQUIRES LANE CLOSURES IN CALHOUN COUNTY

LITTLE ROCK (6-1) – Soil testing on Highway 167 just north of Hampton will require lane closures in Calhoun County, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

The contractor will be taking soil samples at three bridges over Champagnolle Creek, and the lane closure will extend one mile, between log mile 0.70 and 1.70. The work will reduce traffic to one lane, alternately closing the northbound and southbound lanes and shoulders.

The lane closures will begin Wednesday, June 3rd from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. and continue for approximately two weeks, weather permitting. Traffic will be controlled using flaggers.

This work is part of the proposed projects to widen Highway 167, which is part of AHTD's Connecting Arkansas Program. More information on this project is available at ConnectingArkansasProgram.com
