PAVEMENT TESTING REQUIRES INTERSTATE 630 LANE CLOSURES IN LITTLE ROCK

LITTLE ROCK (6-4) – Pavement testing will require lane closures on Interstate 630 in Little Rock, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Crews will be testing the eastbound and westbound pavement between Arkansas Children's Hospital and the Cedar Street overpass (mile marker 2-3). The work will require closing the eastbound and westbound outside lanes within the work zone.

The lane closures will be **Tuesday, June 9th, between 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m., weather permitting.** If weather prohibits, the work will be delayed until Wednesday, June 10th, between 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. Traffic will be controlled using barrels and warning signs.
