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IMPROVEMENTS TO U.S. 67 REQUIRE LANE CLOSURE IN LONOKE COUNTY

LITTLE ROCK (6-4) – Improvements to U.S. Highway 67 will require a lane closure in Lonoke County, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Crews will improve the driving surface on two southbound bridges. The first bridge is located 0.90 of a mile north of the Highway 319 overpass. The second bridge is located 0.75 of a mile north of Highway 319, north of Ward. Both jobs will reduce traffic to one lane between mile markers 25 and 28.

The southbound outside lane closure will be **Monday, June 8th through Thursday, June 11th**, between 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m., each day, weather permitting. Traffic will be controlled using barrels and warning signs.

The first bridge was constructed in 1966. It is 291 feet long and 30 feet wide. The second bridge was constructed in 1969. It is 120 feet long and 39 feet wide.
