ELECTRIC POLE REPLACEMENT REQUIRES I-30 FRONTAGE ROAD LANE CLOSURE IN PULASKI COUNTY

LITTLE ROCK (6-4) – The replacement of electric poles will require a lane closure on an Interstate 30 frontage road in Pulaski County, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

[Entergy](#) crews will replace electric poles along the Interstate 30 eastbound Frontage Road. The work will occur between the Pulaski/Saline County line (mile marker 126) and the Vimy Ridge Road overpass (mile marker 127). It will limit the eastbound Frontage Road traffic to one lane.

The Frontage Road outside lane closure will be **Monday, June 8th through Friday, July 12th**, between 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m., weekdays, weather permitting. Traffic will be controlled using barrels and warning signs.
