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BRIDGE OPENING PREPARATION REQUIRES I-430 & I-630 LANE CLOSURES IN LITTLE ROCK

LITTLE ROCK (6-4) – Work will require Interstate 430 & 630 lane closures in Little Rock, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

If the weather cooperates, crews will complete work on the Interstate 430 southbound to Interstate 630 eastbound ramp/bridge at the “Big Rock” Interchange. Once complete, the ramp will be opened to traffic. **Video of the I-430 southbound to I-630 eastbound ramp can be found at <https://vimeo.com/ahtd/sb430flyover>.**

The preparation work will reduce Interstate 430 southbound to one lane between Rodney Parham Road and the Markham Street exit. Traffic will also be reduced to 1 lane on Interstate 630 eastbound between the Interstate 430 overpass and the on-ramp from Baptist Health.

Weather permitting, the lane closures will begin **Saturday, June 6th at 6:00 a.m. and continue until the work is complete (maybe as late as Monday morning).**
