SIGN INSTALLATION REQUIRES I-630 LANE CLOSURE IN LITTLE ROCK

LITTLE ROCK (6-4) – Sign installation work will require a lane closure on Interstate 630 in Little Rock, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Crews will install an overhead sign at the I-430/630 “Big Rock” Interchange. The work will reduce westbound traffic to one lane between the Baptist Health exit and the ramp leading to I-430 northbound. Traffic may be intermittently stopped in the open lane during the installation.

The I-630 westbound lane closures will be Sunday, June 7th, between 6:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m., weather permitting.
