PAVEMENT STRIPING REQUIRES OVERNIGHT INTERSTATE 430 LANE CLOSURES IN LITTLE ROCK

LITTLE ROCK (6-12) – Pavement striping requires overnight lane closures on Interstate 430 in Little Rock, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

The work will reduce Interstate 430 southbound traffic to one lane between the Pedestrian overpass (just north of W. Markham overpass) and the Shackelford Road exit.

The lane closures will be **Sunday, June 14th through Friday, June 19th**, between 9:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m., each day, weather permitting. Traffic will be controlled using barrels and warning signs.
