PAVEMENT TESTING ON INTERSTATE 630 REQUIRES OVERNIGHT LANE CLOSURES IN LITTLE ROCK

LITTLE ROCK (6-16) – Pavement testing on Interstate 630 will require overnight lane closure in Little Rock, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Crews will be testing the pavement in the eastbound and westbound lanes of Interstate 630 between the Battery Street (Children's Hospital) overpass and the Cedar Street (UAMS/Veteran's Hospital) overpass. The work will require closing the Interstate 630 eastbound and westbound outside lanes within the work zone.

The lane closures will be **Wednesday, June 17th and Thursday, June 18th**, between 2:00 a.m. and 5:00 a.m., each day, weather permitting.
