IMPROVEMENTS TO INTERSTATE 430 REQUIRE OVERNIGHT LANE CLOSURES IN LITTLE ROCK

LITTLE ROCK (6-19) – Improvements to Interstate 430 require lane closures in Little Rock, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Crews will be installing permanent pavement markings on Interstate 430 northbound and southbound. The work will extend south from the Rodney Parham Road overpass (Exit 8) to the Shackelford Road overpass, just south of Kanis Road. The work will reduce Interstate 430 southbound and then northbound traffic to one or two lanes within the work zone.

The lane closures will begin **Monday night, June 22nd through Friday morning, June 26th**, between 9:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m., each night, weather permitting. Traffic will be controlled using, barrels, electronic message boards and warning signs.
