IMPROVEMENTS TO INTERSTATE 630 REQUIRE LANE CLOSURES IN LITTLE ROCK

LITTLE ROCK (6-26) – Improvements to Interstate 630 require lane closures in Little Rock, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Crews will patch pavement on Interstate 630 westbound between Barrow Road and Baptist Health. Westbound traffic will be reduced to two lanes within the work zone. Also, the Interstate 630 westbound to Interstate 430 northbound ramp will be reduced to one lane.

Also, crews will work on lighting beneath the Interstate 430 overpass. This will reduce eastbound and westbound traffic to 2 lanes under the Interstate 430 overpass. Traffic from Interstate 430 southbound to Interstate 630 loop will be required to yield on Interstate 630.

The lane closures will occur **Monday, June 29th through Wednesday, July 1st** between 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m., each day, weather permitting.
