WORK NEAR INTERSTATE 430/630 “BIG ROCK” INTERCHANGE REQUIRES LANE CLOSURES IN LITTLE ROCK

LITTLE ROCK (7-2) – Work near the Interstate 430/630 “Big Rock” Interchange requires lane closures in Little Rock, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Crews will perform various construction and repair jobs near the interchange. The work will require lane closures in the following areas.
