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BRIDGE WORK REQUIRES INTERSTATE 40 LANE CLOSURE IN CONWAY

LITTLE ROCK (7-7) – Bridge work will require a lane closure on Interstate 40 in Conway, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Crews will place a barrier wall to control traffic during the construction of a new 6th Street overpass. The work is being performed just east of Exit 127 (Oak Street) in Conway. The work will require closing the westbound outside lane of Interstate 40 within the work zone.

The westbound outside lane closure will occur **Wednesday night, July 8th through Thursday morning, July 9th** between 8:30 p.m. and 6:00 a.m., weather permitting.

This project is a partnership between the City of Conway and the Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department. Conway is funding 100% of the cost and administering the project with AHTD oversight.
