WORK ON HIGHWAY 167 REQUIRES LANE CLOSURES IN CALHOUN COUNTY

LITTLE ROCK (7-16) –Work on Highway 167 will require lane closures in Calhoun County, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Crews will perform pavement testing on Highway 167. The work will extend north from State Highway 274 to U.S. Highway 79, east of Thornton. The work will reduce traffic to one lane, alternately closing the northbound and southbound lanes and shoulders.

The lane closures will be **Monday, July 20th and Tuesday, July 21st**, from 8:30 a.m. – 6:00 p.m., weather permitting. Traffic will be controlled using cones and flaggers.

This work is part of the proposed projects to widen Highway 167, which is part of AHTD's Connecting Arkansas Program. More information on this project is available at ConnectingArkansasProgram.com
