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BRIDGE INSPECTION REQUIRES LANE CLOSURES ON INTERSTATE 40 IN PRAIRIE COUNTY

LITTLE ROCK (7-17) – A routine bridge inspection will require lane closures on Interstate 40 in Prairie County, according to Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) officials.

Crews will inspect eastbound and westbound bridges over the White River (near mile marker 201). The work will require closing the eastbound and westbound outside lanes.

- The eastbound outside lane closure will occur **Monday, July 20th**, between 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m., weather permitting.
- The westbound outside lane closure will occur **Tuesday, July 21st**, between 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m., weather permitting.

The bridge was constructed in 2013. It is 79 feet wide and 411 feet long.
